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## GENERAL IMMUNIZATION SCHEDULE

(May be slightly different depending on child's individual needs and immunization status)

AGE:	RECOMMENDED IMMUNIZATIONS:
Hospital:	Hep B
1 month:	Hep B
2 months:	IPV, DTaP, Hib, PCV13, Rotavirus
4 months:	IPV, DTaP, Hib, PCV13, Rotavirus
6 months:	Hep B, DTaP, Hib, PCV13, Rotavirus
9 months:	IPV, (Hep B if not given at 1 month)
12 months:	MMR-V, Hib, PCV13
15 months:	DTaP
18 months:	Hep A
2 years:	Hep A
4-6 years:	MMR-V, DTaP, IPV
11-12 years:	Tdap, HPV4, MCV4 (see below)
Additional:	Flu vaccination is recommended each fall for all persons 6 mos of age or older

### ABBREVIATION CODES AND OTHER NOTES:

DTaP: child diphtheria, tetanus, and pertussis (whooping cough)

Tdap: adult tetanus and pertussis

Hib: Haemophilus influenza type B

Hep A and Hep B: Hepatitis A and Hepatitis B

IPV: Polio

PCV13: Pneumococcal 13-valent (Prevnar 13)

HPV4: Human Papilloma Virus. 3 dose series over 6 months time if over 15 years, 2 dose series if under 15 years.

MCV4: Neisseria meningitis (Menactra for meningitis) 1 dose

MMR-V: Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Varicella (Chickenpox). If MMR-V is in national shortage, separate MMR is given at 12 months and Varivax at 15 months.

Rotavirus: an oral vaccine
